2. There will be no rain date, snow date, or other cancellation policy.
- 3. The throwing of any items from floats or cars, including candy, is prohibited**
We encourage you to have people walking with your float or unit handing out candy or gifts to those along the parade route.
- 4. The name of the organization should be clearly visible on both sides of the float for judging purposes.**
5. Off road vehicles, i.e., dirt bikes, four wheelers, etc. are prohibited.
6. Equestrian units & individuals are prohibited unless insured for liability (proof of insurance required).
7. Anyone participating in the parade will need to fill out the attached hold harmless agreement.
- 8. The Chamber will provide the only live Santa and Mrs. Claus to be featured in the parade.**
Any others will be asked to leave.
9. The Swain County Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to refuse any application according to the bylaws of the Swain County Chamber of Commerce.
10. All applicants/entries must be consistent with theme of event and policies of Swain County Chamber of Commerce.

The undersigned agrees that if accepted to participate, he or she will comply with all policies, procedures and regulations included in this application, and agree to be bound and comply with all Christmas Parade documents. Line Up Information—

The line up route will begin at the bottom of Lake View Drive and head up to the high school.

Walking units will be held in the Presbyterian Church parking lot and will be funneled in as their float/vehicle/group comes by.

Parade Route Information—

The Parade will be travelling down Everett Street and make a right onto Main Street. The parade ends at the light at the Main Street and Slope Street intersection (the light at the Shell station).

You may leave the parade at the Main Street light or if you need to get back to the high school to return to your cars turn right onto Slope, and then return to the high school either via Lake View Drive or Bryson Branch Rd.

IF YOU ARE UNLOADING CHILDREN TO PARENTS AFTER THE PARADE, PLEASE MEET PARENTS EITHER BACK AT THE HIGH SCHOOL OR AT VALLEY VILLAGE PARKING LOT. DO NOT LET CHILDREN LEAVE YOUR FLOAT AT THE MAIN STREET LIGHT (IT'S TOO DANGEROUS TO HAVE THEM RUNNING AROUND IN THE STREET).

Due to insurance and liability restrictions the following are prohibited:

- Equestrian individuals unless you can provide proof of liability insurance.
- Off road vehicles, i.e., dirt bikes, four wheelers, etc.

The throwing of candy or any other materials from any moving vehicle/float is strictly prohibited (Kids dart out into traffic to retrieve candy and could be hit by a vehicle/float)

Please have people walking with your float/unit handing out candy or gifts to those along the parade route

Only floats are judged. Judging criteria includes originality, overall appearance, use of theme, and entertainment value. Trophies are awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners. Cash prizes are awarded as follows: 1st place-\$300, 2nd place-\$200, 3rd place-\$100.

Day Of:

- **Arrive early, 12 – 1pm.** It's much easier for the staff and the participants to find their space if you arrive in a timely manner. If you arrive as late as 1:30 – 1:45pm there is a chance that you will not be allowed to participate.
- **Floats & Motorized Units:** when lining up look for the large white sign located in the grass at the curb. Find your assigned number and **line up the front of your vehicle or unit with the sign.**
- **Bands, ALL Walking Units, and Equestrian Units:** meet at Presbyterian Church parking lot. A Chamber staff member will be there to put you in line up order. It's much easier to keep the parade together and cohesive if walking units don't have to walk all the way down the hill.
- If you have any questions, please look for a staff member or volunteer – all of whom will be wearing orange safety vests. Or call Karen at the number below.
- Please have your **VEHICLE STARTED AND READY TO GO BY TEN MINUTES TILL 2 WITH EVERYONE ON THE FLOAT OR IN THE VEHICLE.** We start promptly at 2 and don't want any delays.

The Chamber will be providing the only Santa to be featured in the parade. All others will be asked to leave.
